In the course of doing so, the author identifies the many enemies JFK had in the financial establishment, and highlights the virulent press attacks against the President while in office, which he believes led to the false and inaccurate portrayal of JFK by many historians as either shallow and without many ideas, or as a fiscal conservative who was a tool of the monied establishment.
