Subject: Response to Weberman letter

Draft letter to Weberman (FBI portion)I am writing to respond to issues you raised in your letter of October 26, 1995.(1) The FBI's processing of documents it provided to the HSCA is ongoing. [Indeed, on November __, some ____ additional pages of these documents were released into the JFK Assassination Records Collection at the NARA II facility in College Park, Maryland. Note: This release may take place as early as Thursday, November 2. The bracketed sentence should be included if the release is made before this letter goes out.] As with all FBI assassination records, and as provided by Section 5(e)(1) of the JFK Assassination Records Collection Act, the FBI has released redacted copies of those documents containing information the release of which the FBI wishes to have postponed. The ARRB will make its own determination as to the propriety of each of these claimed postponements.(2) It is the intent of the ARRB to identify and obtain for the Collection all assassination records, regardless of how recently they were created. The FBI already has processed over 350 assassination records dated 1990 through 1994. A search of the database of electronic identification aids for the word "tramps" yields 18 FBI records from the 1990's identified by FBI reviewers as relevant to the "three tramps" issue. All but three of these documents are open in full to the public. Record identification forms for these 18 documents are enclosed. NARA staff at the JFK Assassination Records Collection can retrieve these documents for your review and assist in any follow-up searches.
