Sibert (2 items: interview and affidavit) Sibert-O'Neill Report (non-HSCA) Radm Burkley statement (non-HSCA) As is to be expected from eyewitness testimony, especially years after an event, there are some disparities in what people remember; however, there seems to be one common thread in what they do remember, namely, a large wound in the back of the head between the ears, or behind the right ear. Many of the witness interviews have attached to them diagrams of the President's wounds made by those interviewed. When events permit, I recommend you review all of the witness interviews/statements above which you have not yet seen. END
