Oakes wanted his copyright restrictions concerns adequately addressed prior to the preparation of a Deed of Gift. I have worked with Anne Buttimer, Jeremy Gunn and Luara Denk toward establishing a policy regarding restrictions and an agreeable solution for the donor. See Gum Shoe Issue #9.* Arranged consent re: donation of a computer simulation of Dealey Plaza video tape as well as twelve pages of data and supporting documentation by Dale Myers. Myers wanted his copyright restrictions concerns adequately addressed prior to the preparation of a Deed of Gift. I have worked with Anne Buttimer, Jeremy Gunn and Luara Denk toward establishing a policy regarding restrictions and an agreeable solution for the donor. See Gum Shoe Issue #9.* Continued attempts to contact Patsy Paschall concerning her film. I sent correspondence to her home in order to establish contact and a repore. See Gumshoe Issue #9.* Identified and received a copy of a microfished assassination record detailing the analysis of the Nix and Zapruder films found within the Los Alamos Laboratory. Manuel Legespi was instrumental in identifying a sound initial contact at the Lab based on his knowledge of the facility. See Gum Shoe Issue #41.* Followed up on letter sent via facsimile and Fed Ex to Thomas Young. Young is the son-in-law of Charles Bronson and was authorized by Mrs. Bronson to oversee the disposition of the film in conjunction with the rest of the family. Young was not aware of the Board's interest in the Bronson materials. I left a message offering any clarification on questions or concerns about the Review Board and our interest in donation. See Gum Shoe Issue #62.* Followed up on letter sent via facsimile and Fed Ex to Owen Willard Laughlin, Esq. Laughlin is the son-in-law of Charles Bronson and will be handling Bronson's estate for the family. I left a message offering any clarification on questions or concerns about the Review Board and our interest in donation. Laughlin said that Sigalos' statements to myself as well as to David Marwell were incorrect and that he was told by Charles Bronson there is a clip of the film in a Dallas vault. Laughlin said the clip shows the window of the sixth floor of the TSBD minutes prior to the assassination. See Gum Shoe Issue #62.* Facilitating the ability to perform intelligence gathering on the World Wide Web via CompuServe. I am working with Chet Rhodes and David Marwell to insure compliance with ARRB systems administration regulations. I have received numerous outside contacts via the Internet and pulled down various current JFK related intelligence. See Gum Shoe Issue #9 and I have hard copies of web-sites from other sources.* Postponed 8mm Muchmore film ORSK authentication at Archives II scheduled for today due to the federal government shut down.
