Dooley, whose name Max got from Richard Helms, came from FBI to CIA in the mid-1950s and went to work in CI, where he assisted Ray Rocca in CIA's liaison with the Warren Commission. Max finds Dooley interesting because, unlike Angleton and Rocca, he is not convinced of a Soviet connection to the assassination (from what I heard, it sounds like Dooley comes out pretty much on the side of the Warren Commission report).
