There is a copy on you desk and one attached here as well. Vanilla code 01 needs to be addressed, since we both use it and we each apply different language. Vanilla codes 05 and 06, though rarely, if ever, used by the CIA team, could be a 1A, a 1B, or both, and are therefore not helpful in generating the language which we need. It seems to me that the Vanilla codes are, as are the Postponement codes, imperfect reference points for the Reasons for Board action. Maybe we could each hone one of these imperfect tools to our needs, rather than trying to make one perform multiple tasks. I'd like to talk to Chet to see if he could set up the Review Track system so that the Vanilla codes could generate the Reasons for Board Actions for FBI documents, yet allow the postponement code 1A or 1B to continue as the point of reference for this issue in CIA documents. If he cannot, we will work out another way for this system to function easily for both of us. Thanks.
