Subject: How to record accurate postponement #s when only one is entered

Per your request, I am reminding you that we need to resolve how to handle the small number of cases where only one postponement form is entered even though the document may actually contain many more (eg, SSN's in HSCA payroll documents). In the past, I've used Reviewer's Comments/Location Detail fields to indicate that the one form represents a far larger number of actual postponements [for the record, I've only done this when I had document-specific advance permission from Jeremy]. The question is, how do we ensure that the actual number of postponements ends up in the relevant field on the RIF/postponement summary page and, eventually, on the FDF?Thanks.
