He said that he was familiar with the JFK Act, but that he could not make the records available to the Review Board, as they are considered tax return information controlled by the strictures of section 6103 of the Internal Revenue Code. He told me that earnings reports are compiled from information from taxpayers' W-2 forms. However, if the IRS specifically states that the Social Security Administration can release the earnings records on specific taxpayers, then he would willingly allow us to review the materials.
