He said that they have their meeting with the subcommittee staff on Tuesday, April 23rd. The mark-up is expected in mid-May. John said that the obvious point in our favor is that this is our last budget. He suggested that contact with Hoyer's staff might be appropriate so we will have a better chance of hearing anything if there is a problem. Constance added that May 1 was a good time to evaluate whether or not we wanted to start reaching out to people to find out if they were hearing anything. He acknowledged that it was always a difficult judgment as to whether or not to contact the majority staff again when they are not asking anything further from us right now. John also noted that after the markup we might want to contact Chuck Parkinson on the Senate side. He said that Parkinson would not want to hear from us until then. In review, John thought the key points were: last budget, we have made progress, and cutting the budget would simply mean that we would need longer to get the job done.
