**Subject:** Conversation with Thomas Young re: Bronson Deed of Gift

**Body:** I talked to Thomas Young of Waskom, Texas, by phone today about the Bronson film. He told me that he had discussed a possible donation with his family and that the draft deed of gift that we sent to him was "unacceptable." I again told him that the draft we sent to him was a draft and that we would be happy to work with the family to devise a deed that was acceptable to them and to the Archives. He told me then that the family is not ready to turn over any of their property rights in the assassination material, primarily because they are in the process of hiring a lawyer to represent them in a civil suit against Groden for releasing on video the Bronson film in violation of a written agreement that he would not to release it. The family has decided that it will retain all of its property rights in the materials until the civil litigation is complete. In the meantime, Mr. Young told me that the family will place the material in "appropriate storage" facilities. I asked Mr. Young to keep us informed as to the status of the lawsuit against Groden and to let us know what is happening.
