Subject: weekly update
As you are aware, we met on May 8 with representatives of the State Department and FBI regarding the now-apparently-inevitable appeal on foreign counterintelligence postponements. This appeal will include the records identified in the FBI's draft appeal from last month, as well as up to four records that the Board voted to release at the April meeting. On the FBI discussion agenda for next week's Board meeting (in addition to documents marked for discussion by Board members during individual review):--- Reconsideration of the Lane privacy document, together with other related documents that have been postponed in full on privacy grounds. --- Two or three "defector" documents.--- Between zero and sixteen documents with informant postponements that the Board released in full at last month's meeting. (Ten of these documents all involve the same informant.) There is some possibility that reconsideration will be sought for additional documents involving security informants.
