It is a copy of a London filmaker's film of the assassination. Judge is supposed to provide me with that person's contact information. He said he doesn't think its not a new record but wanted to make sure we knew about it regardless. The tape is labeled: ""GRASSY KNOLL" -N.T.S.C." and includes a short segment of the knoll area at the time of the assassination with what could be interpreted as an area of light appearing on the knoll. This light could only be captured by slowing the tape down to frame-by-frame movements. The assassination segment repeats several times, followed by footage of a reenactment showing a sniper firing rounds with a rifle while being timed.
