The book that the Library of Congress claims was water damaged and thus needs to be replaced is Hoover and the un-Americans by Kenneth O'Reilly. On December 12th Teena Siggers (707-4630) at the Library of Congress informed us that this book, which had been borrowed by the ARRB and returned, has extensive water damage. They could not order a copy from Books in Print and thus recommended a copy be made there by using a photoduplication service. The cost is \$118. Later that month I spoke with Elgin Reid in the Loan Division at 707-5348 and told him we would sign a sworn statement saying we did not damage the book. Mr. Reid was fairly confident that the book was sent out undamaged. He planned to contact the LOC's Office of Inspector General to see what the next step would be. I was later informed by him that the book would have to be replaced and was sent a list of places to try and call regarding obtaining another copy. There has been no pressure on them to replace it by a specific date and no follow up from them since they sent me this list at the end of February. As you know we have found a replacement copy for \$61 and I told Mr. Reid I can get a copy. With regard to getting back the old book for ourselves I was told that it is "government property" and won't be able to get it. This is the situation. Our account number is 54374.
