Subject: Mark Lane/HSCA Numbered Files

This morning I checked Lane references in the HSCA Numbered Files. Nothing new of great note, but one document references the relevant issue: HSCA files contain a 2/14/64 note from "Deke" to Congressman Gerald Ford which, "pursuant to our conversation of February 12," forwards a copy of the three page memo on Lane which we have already come across elsewhere. The sixth paragraph of the first page concerns the Queens County charges. DeLoach references in his note that Ford had "specifically indicated an interest in" the memo. THIS HSCA DOCUMENT IS "REFERRED". I had previously run across a "NARA-FORD" RIF for what is almost certainly the same document. Steve couldn't physically locate this latter record yesterday, which is open, but the comments field of the RIF indicates that "Sixth [relevant for our purposes] paragraph excised." So the relevant text is not open in this unlocated NARA-FORD record, either. Still, it's clear the Bureau was shopping this stuff around. Additionally, in the miscellaneous category, I came across a 2/26/64 WC memo from Willens to Rankin, re: "Mark Lane" which references the issue of FBI surveillance. Lastly, Lane's 2/67 Playboy interview references his surveillance by and run-ins with the FBI, though Lane does not reference the privacy issues of immediate relevance. Copies of these documents will be placed in Jeremy's box.
