Russell, the 9/18/64 WC Executive Session, etc.: Russell got permission to have a personal assistant to help him keep up with the Commission's work (after it became clear that he was missing a lot of sessions and was generally bogged down with his Senate duties). The assistant was a Georgia lawyer named Alfreda Scobey. I've attached to the hardcopy of this E-mail an excerpt from WC staffer Bert Griffin's testimony before the HSCA which contains an interesting reference to Russell and Scobey. Theoretically, Scobey might be a good person to talk to regarding Russell and the Commission, etc.; she might also have insight into the extent/nature of any records Russell might have kept from his WC stint. On the other hand, while still alive, she will be 84 years of age in October. Anne/Dave had done a FinCen on her and we have what purports to be a current address and phone number.
