She does not know what happened to the receipt but assumes it is with the other receipts that Angie Novello signed, possibly under the name 'Bobby Kennedy'."In the July, 1978, memo from William Moss to Trudy Peterson (forwarded previously), Moss indicated that the Kennedy Library staff had searched for such a receipt in vain.In the event, however, that anyone from our staff is perusing the "Evelyn Lincoln/President's Office" files while they're in Boston next week, they might keep an eye out for it!
