Riebe called ARRB Monday afternoon, July 15, about 3:30 P.M. in response to ARRB requests to contact us.He was asked if he stood by his 1989 interview with David Lifton as being an honest interview, and said yes. He was asked if he took pictures at President Kennedy's autopsy, and he said yes. He was asked if he was still of the opinion that the photographs of the back of President Kennedy's head failed to show damage that he saw on the head, and he said yes, that he thought the photo was innaccurate. Mr. Gunn asked him whether he was willing to say this under oath, and he said yes. The final arrangements as to when and where his deposition will be conducted were left open; Mr. Gunn agreed to call him again on Friday, July 19, 1996 to discuss further arrangements for taking a deposition.
