I talked to Warren DeBrueys again about copying MCC records. I told him that we did not have an audiotape of your interview with him. He said "okay" and told me that he wished that you did have one, as his tape is difficult to hear. We talked about his request that we make two copies of each document that we copy and give the MCC one of the sets. He agreed that it would make more sense for us to bring our copy back here and make the MCC a copy of what we have. He said that, as long as we could get the copies to the MCC within a couple of weeks, that would be fine. He then asked if we could have the temporary person use a counter so that he would know how many pages we copy. I told him that I did not think that would be a problem. He said that he would prefer to have a full set of the documents we take, so that he can compare the number from the copying machine to the number of pages we send to them. As I told both of you earlier today, he will be bringing the nine boxes of MCC documents to the warehouse himself. He would prefer not to turn the boxes over to the warehouse delivery people. He will also be at the warehouse to oversee the copying of "his" MCC boxes.
