Subject: Weekly Update

Weekly update for military/medical team:1. Received confirmation that Army will fund TDY for declassification specialist to review Cuba records located at College Park during week of September 3-6.2. Team members attended interview training session conducted by Jeremy on August 16.3. Chris Barger met with new ARRB point of contact in office of Navy General Counsel, Lt Col Finney, on August 15; advised Finney of our efforts with respect to ONI records.4. Acquired records concerning preparation of JFK gravesite from Army Corps of Engineers. These records will be stored in ARRB offices pending transfer to NARA. Purpose of storing records at ARRB is to have them available to compare with additional set of records allegedly held by Arlington Cemetery related to the same topic. (Brian Rosen is working on gaining access to Arlington records.)5. Reviewed SF 135's at Suitland to determine extent of holdings in Federal Repository from DIA and ONI. Both agencies have extensive records at Suitland contemporaneous with assassination and which presumably have never been searched in compliance with JFK Act.6. Began project to ascertain formal procedures/regulations under which records from various DOD agencies are destroyed/stored/accessioned. Purpose of this project is to compare "official" procedure with actual practices both by agencies and NARA to determine possible whereabouts of additional, "overlooked" records.
