17, 1996.The hearing will be held in the Los Angeles Board of Education Hearing Room which is Room H-160,
located on the first floor of 450 North Grand Avenue. The Board will hear a wide range of expert testimony
on the identification and location of assassination records and receive an update from a National Archives
representative on the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection. A witness list will be

California*****The Assassination Records Review Board was established by The President John F.
Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act, which was signed into law by President George Bush. The five
members of the Board were appointed by President Clinton, confirmed by the U.S. Senate, and sworn in on
April 11, 1994. The law gives the Review Board the mandate and the authority to identify, secure, and make
available all records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. It is the responsibility of the Board to
determine which records are to be made public immediately and which ones will have postponed release
