This is a record from letter 14 that the FBI had listed as a consent release and which we printed as a consent release in the federal register notice that went out in August. Today Deb Beatty called to say that the Bureau had incorrectly listed this as a consent release, and intended to list it as a "protect numeric only." The record involves a symbol-number informant that the Board has handled on a "protect numeric" basis on at least one prior occasion. The Bureau wanted to know whether there was any way they could "take back" the consent release, even though it had been listed in the federal register. I talked to David about the request, and he decided it would be appropriate to accede to the Bureau's request, in order not to "chill" the identification of consent releases in the future. In the next federal register, we should note that the prior identification of this record by the FBI as a consent release was incorrect. Kevin, please make note of this and make sure we do so when the time comes. Thanks.
