FYI only. In Entry 27 (Box 4) of the Warren Commission records, there is a 101-page report (dated 2/17/64) by WC staffer Samuel Stern entitled "Report on Security Measures to Protect the President." I didn't look at it, but it is open and might possibly be of interest to you (I presume -- and it is only a presumption -- that it contains a lot of stuff relevant to the USSS). You've probably already seen this; I have no idea how it differs from what ended up in the final Report; I also don't know why I came across it in Entry 27 and whether it may also be present and available in Entry 22, Records Relating to the "Protection of the President."
