Subject: Entry 27 (Box 4) of the Warren Commission records

In addition to the Stern report entitled "Report on Security Measures to Protect the President," there are other items in Entry 27, Box 4 that are somewhat interesting. There is a 3/20/64 memorandum about an interview with Mr. Bouck about the PRS files - what they are, and the PRS liaison with other Federal agencies. The memo notes Bouck and Kelly's views re whether they should have been informed about Oswald and the FBI's view of him pre-assassination. Another item was a memo (4/21/64) about the work to be done in the Presidential protection area in which Samuel Stern worked. Other items were a History of the Secret Service (4/2/64) report from Richard Mosk to Stern and a 4/2/64 History of Presidential Protection report.
