Subject: FBI Records

I was distressed to learn that you decided not to review any of the FBI documents that had been assigned to you for the last meeting. Your decision to ignore this assignment amounts to letting the burden fall on your colleagues, who, despite busy schedules and competing claims on their time, were able to get their assignments done. When you came to me to share your concern about the assignment, I told you that, although I would not relieve you of your FBI responsibilities, you should come to me if you found yourself unable to carry out all of your assigned responsibilities so that I could help sort out and assign priorities. I fear that you are trying to make a some sort of point through your decision not to review the FBI records, and that you are consequently not acting in a manner that is in the best interests of this office. Let's try to avoid unnecessary difficulties in the short time that we have left.
