Subject: Dinneen material and Prot. surveys

Laura and I spoke with the lawyer from NARA (Amy Krupsky?) who told us that these items will not be numbered in the "180" group. They will be located close to the 180 group and indexed with cross references. She said Steve Tilley would have a number for them. Amy said that a note regarding their status and indicating that these documents were outside the government would be included with the Dinneen documents. They will be considered a donation. Amy and Laura discussed contacting Dinneen for a deed of gift. I relayed this information to Steve, who implied he had not yet heard the results of Amy's deliberations with the Center for Legislative Archives people. He said he did not yet have a number for the Dinneen material but thought it could start with "200." I briefly discussed our timetable regarding all the Dinneen materials, i.e. November 13, 1996, and I suggested that we would like to have RIF numbers by then. He said he understood why we needed them for tracking purposes, and he would get RIF numbers on them. I also mentioned that we would be asking the USSS for evidence on some of the protective surveys. He said it will be fine for Machado to come up and read the protective surveys. Steve indicated that he would not let Machado have any originals. Steve is reluctant to let any originals out of the Archives.
