Subject: State Department

This morning I have called Jackie Lilly, Mrs. Olson, Gladys Boluda, Nerissa Cook, Dave Hanzlik, Nina Noring; and I called Mrs. Olson's office again to get the name and address of her office so I could convey that to Nina Noring, who lectures me on the fact the the State Department is very large and they don't know any of the people of whom I speak or who is handling various phases of these plans or at what stage we are on this and they can't help me unless I give them proper information. Many times we are told to call someone else, then that person asks why we would be calling them, that someone else should be handling it. The cables to Moscow, Minsk, and London that we faxed to Grafeld's office on October 17 were not sent until October 21. We do not have any response from those. I told Noring that the things we do not have are visas, appointments, and accommodations. Mrs. Olson just called me back at a little after 11:00. She said the Belarus visa is okay. She said Russia just gives a piece of paper to put in the passport. They submitted to the embassy on the 15th and it takes at least a week, so they won't get it until today or tomorrow. She is trying to contact the courier on this now. Dave Hanzlik also called me back at the same time and wanted to know why you want to go to Minsk, the purpose, and to see whom. I said we are mandated by Congress to find all records related to the assassination from both government and private sources, place records in the National Archives, etc.
