O'Neal already copied the file, and the ATF order re destruction of files, and mailed them to us. He will retain the original of the file, which is not very large, in case we want to review it. We also spoke about ATF records on the assassination generally. The following points came out:--ATF was under IRS prior to 1971. O'Neal doubts that any pre-1971 records remain.--As to materials that may have been provided to the HSCA, O'Neal says that an Evonne Spear in the Document Services Branch of ATF (927-8930) said the Kennedy materials had already been turned over, although he was not certain to whom. He suggested I call her.--As for archival materials in Dallas, he suggested I call the Divisions Operations Officer for the Dallas Field Office(214-767-2250).--O'Neal continues to maintain that archived materials can only be retrieved by a criminal investigation or case number and that these cannot be cross-referenced to case name for before 1975, I believe he said.I will follow-up on the two O'Neal contacts.
