Spear and Rudy GarciaDescription of the Call Date: 10/07/96Subject: ATF's Assassination RecordsSummary of the Call:Call No. 1 to Evonne Spear--She had no relevant information, had simply been aware of prior requests of the ARRB and that no records had been located at ATF in response thereto.Call No.2 Divisions Operations Officer of the Dallas Field Office (Rudy Garcia)--Reiterated that ATF's criminal investigative files are destroyed after 20 years and that the Federal Records Center sticks to this schedule. He has worked with Eric O'Neal to locate records. He has found nothing using the computerized index to files. He acknowledged that pre-1970 files would not be on the computerized index, and he has tried to locate earlier "paper" indices but without success. Even assuming there might still be pre-1970 files at the Federal Records Storage facility, he said, there is no index to them that he has located. He is having pulled from storage a 1977 Masen file per Eric O'Neal's request. Will call when he has it.
