New Chairs of Congressional Committees Announced -- On November 22,the House Republicans announced that Representative Dan Burton (D-IND)will chair the House Government Reform and Oversight Committee, which hasoversight responsibility for the Nat ional Archives. Burton replacesWilliam Clinger (R-PA) who retired. Also on November 22 Representative RobLivingston (R-LA), the chair of the House Appropriations Committee,announced that Jim Kolbe (R-AZ) will head the Appropriations Subcommitteeon th e Treasury, Postal Service, and General Government, which determinesthe budgets for the National Archives and the National HistoricalPublications and Records Commission (NHPRC). For some time, there hadbeen indications that Representative Ernest Istook (R-OK) would head thissubcommittee.On the Senate side, the Republicans plan to announce the selection ofcommittee chairs next week. Senator Richard Shelby (R-ALA) who haschaired the Appropriations Subcommittee on the Treasury, Postal Service,and General Government, which has responsib ility for the NationalArchives and NHPRC budgets, is expected to move on to chair the SenateSelect Intelligence Committee. Thus there is some speculation as to whowill replace Shelby.
