Burton replacesWilliam Clinger (R-PA) who retired. Also on November 22 Representative RobLivingston (R-LA), the chair of the House Appropriations Committee, announced that Jim Kolbe (R-AZ) will head the Appropriations Subcommitteeon the Treasury, Postal Service, and General Government, which determines the budgets for the National Archives and the National Historical Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC). For some time, there hadbeen indications that Representative Ernest Istook (R-OK) would head thissubcommittee. On the Senate side, the Republicans plan to announce the selection of committee chairs next week. Senator Richard Shelby (R-ALA) who has chaired the Appropriations Subcommittee on the Treasury, Postal Service, and General Government, which has responsib ility for the National Archives and NHPRC budgets, is expected to move on to chair the Senate Select Intelligence Committee. Thus there is some speculation as to who will replace Shelby.
