You were right, the Board did act on some CIA documents in October, 32 of them. Unfortunately, I don't have them here, and I have no idea of their content. In November there were 66 CIA documents, almost all from the first dozen boxes of the JFK collection. To some degree they are the usual mixed bag with some Mexico City documents, some Cuba documents and a couple with Soviet connections. But for the most part, this group of documents relate to the work of the HSCA and CIA's responses to and discussions of ways to respond to HSCA requests. These include responses to requests for information on names, discussions of HSCA plans to interview individuals and discussions of appearances of CIA officers before the HSCA, as well as discussions of
