The meeting has been rescheduled to Jan. 16. In connection with the meeting, Mr. Blevins and I reviewed several matters: The general categories of records maintained by the SSA are (1) earnings records (w-2 forms and records generated therefrom); (2) applications for social security numbers; and (3) benefits records. Blevins wants to know for whom we would want such records in addition to Oswald and Ruby; we need to consider this and give Mr. Blevins guidance by the time of our meeting. Mr. Blevins indicated that he is looking into whether the SSA did any investigation or other work in connection with the Warren Commission. Only the earnings records are considered tax return records for purposes of Section 6103 of the IRS Code; benefits and SSN applications are not covered by Section 6103.
