Subject: TV archive Film

I talked with Don Elder, a veteran TV reporter and government public relations person, regarding network TV archives and what might be in them. Most importantly, Don believed that the networks probably retained all the uncut film of interviews, etc. in their libraries, making copies to edit for reports and special broadcasts. These originals are probably still in network TV archives. Don believes, and so do I, that the networks will be extremely propriety about these films, choosing not to give us the original, but perhaps will make copies, at our cost. Finding these films may be extremely labor intensive. Don suggests first approaching the networks to see what might be in their archives and then approaching the networks for the material. We can expect the networks to be very resistive to giving us the films.
