Here are my suggestions for tomorrow's Air Force Meeting: -Andrews AFB Tower Log for 11/22/63 (Reason: we are interested in helicopter flights in and out of Andrews shortly before and after Air Force One and Air Force Two landed at Andrews--we want to know the times helicopters arrived and departed Andrews, their tail numbers, origin and destination, and service [Army, Air Force, USAF, etc.].)-Crew Lists for Air Force One and Air Force Two from 11/22/63--we need all names, ranks, and hopefully service numbers (if available) for the total crew on each Special Air Mission flight for 11/22/63 from Love Field in Dallas, to Andrews AFB in Washington. [The two flights are SAM 26000 and SAM 86970.]-Papers or files of USAF Brigadier General Godfrey McHugh, Air Force Aide to President Kennedy.-Audiotape recordings (or transcripts) of Air Force One (SAM 26000) voice transmissions during 11/22/63 flight from Dallas (Love Field) to Andrews. One of the stations on the comm link was identified as "Andrews," so it is conceivable that the Air Force may have a tape of the complete voice transmissions (3 frequencies in full time use for 2 hours and 40 minutes), or perhaps a tape of the conversations with the station identified as "Andrews" on the heavily edited tapes from the LBJ library. (ARRB's goal is to find unedited tapes of all three frequencies in full time use for the entire flight--this description came from the comm officer on SAM 26000, who wrote a statement in November 1963 of his
