located Bruce Jamieson through the information operator in Dallas, called him, and ascertained that he is
indeed the Jamieson of the Jamieson Film Company, the lab which exposed (but did not develop) the 3 first-
generation copies of the Zapruder Film on 11/22/63 in Dallas.He agreed to a telephonic interview with the
ARRB on Friday, March 7, 1997 at 11:00 EST (10:00 CST, where he lives).He said the company no longer exists.
I asked him if he could ascertain the whereabouts of Mr. Frank R. Sloan, the Jamieson Film Co. laboratory
manager who signed Abraham Zapruder's affidavit on 11/22/63 (since I could not find him through the Dallas
information operator). He said he believes that Mr. Sloan no longer lives in Dallas, but that he would try to find
out where he lives now, prior to our interview on Friday. END
