RiebeDescription of the Call Date: 03/28/97Subject: Doug Horne Called Floyd RiebeSummary of the Call:I reached Floyd Riebe today and ascertained that he had indeed received our letter of February 26, 1997 which invited him to provide testimony under oath in Washington regarding his participation in the photography of President Kennedy's autopsy. After some discussion, I was able to get Mr. Riebe to tentatively agree to come to Washington during the first half of May to view the autopsy photographs, answer questions, and provide sworn testimony.(He made very clear that he wanted to rest awhile, and would not be immediately available, because he had just retired. May seemed much more amenable to him then April, which we had proposed in our letter.)I proposed to him that he fly to Washington about Tuesday, May 6, stay overnight in a hotel, and testify on Wednesday, May 7, and then fly home later that day. I asked if I could call him in a week or two and propose final travel arrangements to him, and he said that would be O.K.I will work with Jeremy and Tracy on the proposed dates/travel arrangements before calling Mr. Riebe back.
