Description of the Call Date: 05/02/97Subject: Doug Horne Called Jamie SilverbergSummary of the Call:I called Jamie for the second time today; the first time was on Friday, April 18. On that occasion I asked him if he had had any success in locating the original Zapruder "home movie" (i.e., side A of Zapruder's film developed on 11/22/63: the non-assassination side), and whether he had had a chance yet to contact Time, Inc. and inquire as to whether they still had possession of the 4" X 5" color slides of each frame of the Zapruder film. (These were actions which he had volunteered to undertake on April 10, 1997 during a visit I made to his office to examine the various Z-film products which had been turned over to LMH Company by Time, Inc. in 1975.)This call was just a "tickler" re: the issues raised in my voice mail of April 18th. Mr. Silverberg began the telephone conversation by saying that he was unsure what effect the actions taken by the Board on April 24th (re: future disposition of the Z-film) would have on the searches he had promised to undertake on our behalf--i.e., what effect would the Board's decisions of April 24th have on these items if he were to find them?--a rhetorical question which I did not attempt to answer. I told him I could sympathize with any uncertainties which the recent decisions by the Board may have raised in regard to the issues we were discussing. He continued, saying that fallout from the Board's recent decisions had kept him quite busy, and he had not had much time to devote yet to these two searches.As we talked, the atmosphere improved, and he ended up by thanking me for my call and saying that he would try to devote some time in the near future to finding these two items. He even encouraged me to call him late next week and tickle him again if I felt so inclined. I told him that if I were to call him on this matter again, it would be the week after next.END
