There is nothing in these two documents that the Navy would want to hold. I called Lt. Col. Finnie in order to find out who at the Navy can quickly mark these declassified. He checked on it and called me back. He told me that there is no central Navy declassifier. They do not expect to higher someone for sixty days. When I asked him how was I supposed to get these documents declassified, he said take them to the originator.The originator for one of these documents is the CINCLANT and for the other it the navy Attachē½ along with Army and Airforce attache's in Santiago Chile. He said that ONI could probably handle the Attache document. Regarding CINCLANT, Finnie said that they have their own declassifier and that he will find the POC for CINCLANT.Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
