He was stationed in Florida, in the Miami/Keys area and was alleged to have been the "gatekeeper" for Cuban exile paramilitary activities in the Caribbean. He was also rumoured to have been questioning Cuban exiles active in the fight against Castro if they had any information on the assassination of President JF Kennedy in the immediate days following 22 November 1963.
