I told him the most likely time for this event would be the week of July 21-25. I asked him whether two telexes form the White House dated Sep 01 and 02, 1963--the first on the JFK-Cronkite Interview, and the second on Vietnam Policy--had been declassified yet. [ARRB located these on Army PTC microfilm.] In each case, the answer was yes. The SEP 01 telex was declassified in 1987 and is available at the JFK Library. The SEP 02 telex, a draft cable to Ambassador Lodge, is in FRUS Volume 4 on Vietnam, AUG-DEC 1963. He said Bob Skwirot of our staff was reviewing a group of about 300 originally identified NSC documents (which are responsive) to see which are not yet declassified. He estimates that only about 100 are not yet declassified. He intends to make these available for joint review at our group declassification session in July. I told him that ARRB would be formally notifying the various agencies concerned when the declassification
