My fax consisted of a draft news release about the Rankin papers donation to the JFK Collection, and a cover note stating that I will provide her with extra copies of the release and selected documents to be distributed by her office in the event they receive calls.She said that 15 copies of the selected materials will be plenty.She was a little concerned that the Archives will probably not do an advance media advisory, because people on her news release list get "cranky" when there is no advance notice. She suggested we may want to put our release out a day or two earlier -- she understands that we don't do it that way, but just wanted her suggestion "out there." I explained that advance notice being important to the people on her list would be the purpose for the Archives (implying 'not the Review Board') to do an advance media advisory, but that it was my understanding that there probably would not be one. (Author's note: the tone of the conversation was cordial. It may seem to be otherwise, but I noted that portion of our conversation above because I told her I would pass it along.) We agreed to be in touch soon, and I told her I would get the selected samples to her ASAP..
