KovakasDescription of the Call Date: 06/26/97Subject: Civil Division ComplianceSummary of the Call:On June 23, I called Jim Kovakas (Compliance Official for the Civil Division), to check whether they will be submitting their Final Compliance Statement by July 1. They asked for additional time to July 22, which I agreed to.With respect to our request that they identify their FOIA files and designate pertinent parts as assassination records, Kovakas indicated that the Civil Division will send a formal, separate letter response on that issue. Kovakas indicated the letter will be sent in a week or so. In short, the Division will take the position that it does not have the resources and cannot commit to our proposals regarding FOIA files. (In our Febr. 15. 1997 Letter to the Civil Division, we had asked them to list their FOIA cases dealing with JFK asassination materials; to identify in camera submissions; and to ask the courts not to destroy any FOIA case files relating to JFK asassination materials.) Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
