I told him we expected it to be the week of July 21, and that we would soon confirm by fax.He reiterated that he would probably have to send us Toni Bowie again, since he only has two declassifiers, and she is the only one with any experience--the other person is new to the field and had never declassified documents. I said that our concern was not personalities, or whom was sent, but that the person he sends understands that they represent the entire U.S. Army, and has received proper guidance from someone within the Army on how to deal with Cuban covert action issues circa 1963; he said he was trying to obtain such guidance. [Perhaps more to the point are the requirements of Section 6 of the JFK Act, which I previously faxed to him.] ENDDon't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
