He said that it was possible, but that the two individuals who came to mind wrote contemporaneous accounts of what happened on 11/22/63. They are D.L. Jackson, a motorcycle cop, and James Tague, a private citizen who was injured by one of the shots during the assassination. He knows of no officers who have told him that they have records that they kept related to the assassination.
