FROM: Tom Samoluk/ARRBDate: 08/11/97 10:42:58 AMSubject: Review of White House Schedule and Appointment Information at the JFKL (HARD COPY BEING FAXED WITH ATTACHMENTS)Per our prior discussions, I reviewed the relevant records at the JFK Library on scheduling and appointments. The following is a review of the records.1. Secret Service (Record Group 87)White House Post/Gate LogsA. These are logs like the ones that Irene faxed to me from the LBJ Library. According to the inventory, there were 17 different gates, 8 are marked as "Unidentified Gates." I looked at some of these gate logs for the dates that Mark Allen had given you. The name in which you are interested appears on the following logs that I copied:Attachment 1 - August 8, 1961, Gate E-4, 12:45 pm, line 2Attachment 2 - August 8, 1961, Gate E-1, 12:45 pm, line 3Attachment 3 - August 10, 1961, Gate E-4, 4:55 pm, last line on pageThere are many, many boxes of these logs. I hope this sampling is helpful.B. White House Police "Card Index Daily Reports"You had raised the possibility that references to White House Police "Card Index Daily Reports" in the JFK Library inventory might be the same as LBJ Form WH-21 "appointment slips." They are not. As indicated in the JFKL inventory, "There are also a few completed White House Police "Card Index Daily Reports" which are noted on the folder title list and are filed in with their respective logs." I have copied a sample (Attachment 4). As you will see, they are not the same as the WH-21 forms.2. Presidential Movements LogAs indicated in the JFK Library inventory, there is only 1 book of "POTUS Moves" and that is for 1963. It contains a chronology like you have from the LBJ Library. I have attached two pages (Attachment 5) from the 1963 book. No indication of where books for 1961 and 1962 might be located.3. Diary Record Books of the White House Police, 1961-63As indicated in the JFK Library inventory where the instructions for these books are excerpted, these books recorded the "Movements of the President and First Lady leaving or entering the White House, but not their movements inside the White House" other than in a few instances (tours, for example). I have attached a sample page (Attachment 6).4. The President's ScheduleThe President's typed schedule is contained in several books. It appears to be the official record of what the President did, compiled after the fact. It gives the specific times of when he did everything of an official nature. However, there are long gaps where the schedule indicates, for example, "1:25 p.m. To the Mansion" and the next appointment is not until 4:00 p.m. I looked at the specific dates given to you by Mark Allen and there are no references to the person whom we have discussed, but some gaps in the schedule. 5. Evelyn Lincoln CollectionI went through the recently opened Lincoln collection. She had an incomplete copy of The President's Schedule (Number 4 above) and some calendar books, but nothing of any use. After I reviewed all of the above, I showed Megan the WH-21 Form Record
