* All of these people are very friendly & easy to work with...David Petree = Agency Director NPRC9700 Page AveSt. Louis, MO 63132 Bill Siebert = archivist in charge of military records area 314-538-4216; fax= 314-538-4139Wilson Sullivan = archivist working for Siebert (responds quickly to e-mail)Bill Bassman = archivist in charge of civil service records area called "Winnebago"314-425-5751; fax=314-425-5719Gary Maxwell = archivist working for Bassman314-425-5733; fax=314-425-5770*hotel is just off Page Avenue & is about 10-15 minutes from the Page facility*NPRC's Page facility is a big green (not so attractive) building on the right hand side of Page Avenue as you approach ...Merely flash your credentials & proceed left past the guard desk until you see a main entrance on your right (about 200 feet around a circular drive)...Park in any space not marked reserve ...Your credentials will allow you to proceed past the security desk w/out passing through the detectors (there's usually a wait) & the Main Research Room is the 1st door on the right (no sign)...Ask for Ms. Penny & she will call Siebert down to assist you...*NPRC's Winnebago facility is an "elementary school" looking building located near the Anheuser-Busch brewery w/in St. Louis proper... Merely head toward downtown St. Louis, pass the Arch & it is w/in 4-5 city blocks (ask Bassman or Maxwell for the street address)...This facility is appx 15 miles from the hotel & maybe 20 or so from the Page facility...
