Subject: Status of J-Track Projects

As you requested here are the outstanding J-Track projects assigned to me along with short descriptions of their status:-George Bush -Draft letter to CIA was written months ago. We made Bush part of our informal requests to CIA (CIA-IR-09). I believe that CIA still had no information that could answer the question, who was the George Bush of the CIA mentioned in the FBI memorandum of November 29, 1963. I don't think that this matter is worth pursuing further.-Claude Barnes Capehart -Became part of our informal requests for information early this year (CIA-IR-07).-William Gaudet. -This individual who worked for the CIA applied for Mexican entry papers on the same day as Oswald- September 17, 1963. There are more than 50 records in the HSCA collection, including a deposition and interview. Gaudet was among the list of names in Request CIA-17. Though I haven't looked at this material in some time, my guess is that we have gotten all that we will on Gaudet.Howard Guebler - Guebler was with the informal requests to CIA of early this year. I think that Jeremy was following up on him.Joseph Piccolo, Jr. -Piccolo, an operations officer in Mexico City '57-'60 & '65-'68 and with anti-Cuban operations "62-'68, told the HSCA that he was shown photographs of Lee Harvey Oswald that were represented to him as production from the CIA's Mexico City surveillance of the Cuban diplomatic compound. We considered interviewing him. Dave Montague located someone who is a very likely match, but the matter was not purused any further.
