Body: On May 2, 1963, DOJ issued a press release announcing the appointment of John E. Nolan, Jr. to become the "administrative assistant" for RFK, replacing James W. Symington. The release was picked up and published by, apparently, the Washington Post. (I have seen the clipping, which is itself undated). His personnel records reflect that he began work at DOJ on April 10, 1963 and that he resigned effective August 28, 1964. There does not seem to be any covert about this. Do you have any information to the contrary?
