**Subject:** Monthly Report to Congress -- Compliance

Tom -- In connection with the report to Congress, the following compliance-related matters have occurred since the last report --1. We have received final compliance statements from the Social Security Administration and from the Joint Staff. There have been other developments, but they are probably not sufficiently significant to report. Nonetheless, they are as follows:1. We had a meeting with the Department of the Army to discuss what they need to do to complete their compliance under the JFK Act.2. We have evaluated the Final Compliance Statements of the following agencies and have written to them either confirming that they have discharged their obligations under the JFK Act or indicating that they need to do more follow-up to complete their work -- the Army's Central Security Facility, Criminal Investigative Command, and Armed Forces Institute of Pathology; Bethesda Naval Hospital; the Civil Rights Division of DOJ; the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms; Customs; the Postal Service; and the White House Communications Agency (actuallly, maybe you might want to include this in the letter). 3. We are preparing a letter to the Civil Division regarding the treatment of FOIA litigation files under the JFK Act.4. We have designated as assassination records certain organized crime materials of the Criminal Division.5. We have written to the Commissioner of IRS and the Librarian of Congress to obtain greater cooperation from them under the JFK Act. Let me know if
