We discussed our serious concern that CIA was not on target to complete its "re-review" by September 30, 1998. We made it extremely clear that we wanted to work with the Agency to accomplish this, but it needed to be done in an orderly way. I advised them that I have reported to Chairman Burton's staff and to the Board that I have serious concerns that the work might not be accomplished if the present course is continued, and reiterated our willingness to vote to open in full un-reviewed records if that were the only way to finish the task. John Pereira said that he is of the opinion that we do have the legal authority to do this, and that he presumes that we will take that step if necessary. We presented figures, based upon CIA's own estimates and timetable, that 6000 pages per week need to be processed in order to meet the current May 31 target date. (The 6000 includes duplicates, consent releases, etc.). Barry agreed to pay close attention to the number of pages reviewed per week by analysts during the month of December so that we can have a better method of tracking our progress. CIA assured us that they will finish processing all of the records in a timely manner, and that they will answer all of our requests for
